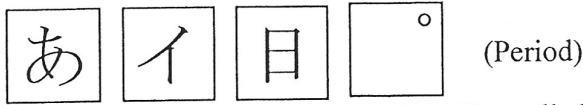
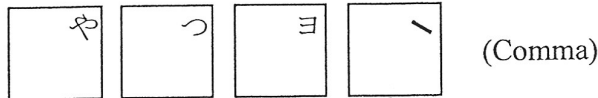


げんこうようし(Japanese-style paper) の使い方

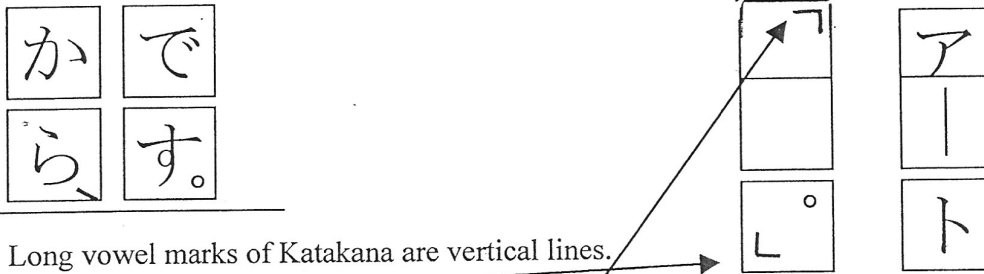
- 1) Write vertically, from top to bottom, right to left.
- 2) Use one box for every character and punctuation mark.



- 3) All small characters, periods and commas go in the upper right hand corner in the box.



Exceptions: If a sentence ends in the last box, put period or comma in the same box with the character.



- 4) Long vowel marks of Katakana are vertical lines.
- 5) Quotation marks:
- 6) Write the title in the first line. The first character is in the fourth box from the top.
- 7) Write your name on the second line. Don't use the last box of the line. In Katakana, your name goes FIRST_NAME · LAST_NAME (put a dot in-between).
If you write your name in Kanji, it goes LAST_NAME FIRST_NAME (put a blank box in-between).
- 8) Start your composition on the third line.
Indent one box when starting a paragraph.
Whenever you start a new paragraph, start it in the second box of the line.
- 9) There are no blank boxes between sentences.
The second sentence starts immediately after the period.
